Consult endocrinology when (please check box that applies to your patient):

Pre-pubertal or pubertal glandular enlargement >0.5 cm of male breast, unilateral or bilateral

Note: mild gynecomastia is common in pubertal males and generally does not require investigation or referral.

Information Required:

If pre-pubertal or atypical features

Triaging Urgency for Gynecomastia Appointments:

- If pre-pubertal-**semi-urgent**
- If Pubertal-**Elective**

We strive to meet the triaging times (below), but please note that times may vary in particular for non-urgent or elective referrals.

Categories for Urgency:

Emergent- contact staff endocrinologist on call (905) 521-5030

Urgent – within 7 days – contact staff endocrinologist on call before sending referral (905) 521-5030

Semi-urgent– 1 to 4 weeks

Non-urgent – 4-16weeks

Elective– Next available
