Categories for Urgency:

Emergent- *contact staff endocrinologist on call (905) 521-5030*

Urgent – within 7 days – *contact staff endocrinologist on call before sending referral (905) 521-5030*

Semi-urgent– 1 to 4 weeks

Non-urgent – 4-16weeks

Elective – Next available
